Pastor's Corner

Dear Parishioners,

This is the second part of a two-part catechesis on the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Last week the theology and sacramental form of the sacrament was covered while this second part will explain who should receive the sacrament and the special form the sacrament takes for the dying.

Recipients of the Sacrament

Great care and concern should be taken to see that those of the faithful whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age receive this sacrament. The sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after being anointed and then again falls ill or if during the same illness the person's condition becomes serious. A sick person may be anointed before surgery whenever a serious illness is the reason for the surgery. Elderly people may be anointed if they have become notably weakened even though no serious illness is present. Sick children are to be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be strengthened by this sacrament. The Sacrament of Anointing is to be conferred on sick people who, although they have lost consciousness or the use of reason, have, as Christian believers, at least implicitly asked for it when they were in control of their faculties.

Viaticum for the Dying

At the end of a Catholic's life a priest should always be called to administer the Anointing. The final celebration of this sacrament at the end of a person's life is referred to as "The Last Rites" and the final reception of Holy Communion as "Viaticum". The word "Viaticum" when translated from the Latin literally means "on the way (via) with (cum) you (te)" - Jesus accompanies and leads us in the final passage from our earthly life to that of heaven. When in their passage from this life Christians are strengthened by the Body and Blood of Christ in Viaticum, they have the pledge of the resurrection that the Lord promised: "Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood have eternal life, and I will raise them up on the last day" (John 6:54). All baptized Catholics who are able to receive Holy Communion are bound to receive Viaticum by reason of the precept to receive Holy Communion when in danger of death from any cause. The celebration of this sacrament should take place while people are still in possession of their faculties. In this way a person is also able to make a good confession. Finally, at the end of these Last Rites the priest proclaims the Apostolic Pardon spoken by him on behalf of the Holy Father asking God for a remission of all the temporal punishment owed for the person's sins and a swift entrance into heaven.
